

If you answer in faith "Yes!" to these questions, you are invited to come forward and partake of the LORD'S Supper during Distribution. By your coming forward, "You proclaim the LORD'S death until He comes."

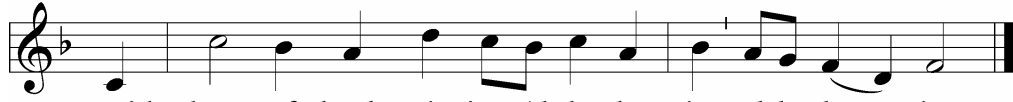
