

Sunday School Assistant Teacher/Leader Ministry Description

Serve as the class fellowship leader:

- Engage class members in brief conversation.
- Contact first-time guests within 3 days (phone, email, social network, personal visits, cards etc.).
- Check up on absentees (no more than once a month).

Serve as class prayer leader:

- Gather prayer requests from students.
- Pray for class members listed in red on class roster (first time visitors, infrequent attendees, unchurched).

Serve as class outreach leader:

- Pray for class members' unchurched friends.
- Solicit ways to assist those on the prayer list (invitations to class or social events, fellowship cards, etc.).

Serve class as substitute teacher:

Becoming a co-teacher/leader can be a great way to learn about teaching children of all ages. We are looking for those committed to the spiritual, intellectual, social and physical growth of our children.
